
TAKING IT PERSONALLY:

JACKSON KATZ, Ph.D. is an American educator, author, and cultural theorist who is internationally renowned for his pioneering scholarship and activism on issues of gender and violence. In 1993, he co-founded Mentors in Violence Prevention (MVP), one of the longest-running and most widely influential sexual assault and relationship abuse prevention programs in high schools, colleges, sports culture and the military, in North America and beyond. He also created the award-winning documentaries, *Tough Guise* and *Tough Guise 2*, and is the author of *The Macho Paradox: Why Some Men Hurt Women and How All Men Can Help*, and *Man Enough?: Donald Trump, Hillary Clinton* and the *Politics of Presidential Masculinity*. He lectures extensively in the U.S. and around the world on violence, media and masculinities.
